Questions:

- Sam Evans – how are we going to get girls to play? Andy xplained we will speak to Campbell about girls only sessions and initiatives that have worked along with funding. This is in the development plan. Saturday morning attendance is good but not for girls. Discussed how to integrate them into sessions and get older girl players to come down as hitters/helpers.

Mythili – Are we entering an U16 team – No, we have an under 18 south west league team and an under 20's shires league team. Sol and Andy to look at numbers on Saturday morning and Tuesday evening sessions.

Restricted: Question was asked why small entry of juniors when clubs have so many players. There will be a discussion of a plate in the juniors and we will hold talks with the clubs about entries. This will be subject to the size of entry into the tournament.

Some tournaments to be run by county donated by PC.



Selection: Daves/Sam - Can we make players play singles at the restricted? This is probably a no, but people should be encouraged to do so.

Can we revisit the selection policy? Chris and Andy to revisit this and make amendments where needed.

Facebook Page: Can we make sure that all players are in the Facebook group for 1sts and 2nds - Yes

George: Are the sessions on offer for community going to be able to continue and are we able to meet the demand if it grows. Yes but the offering might have to change, less sessions etc.

Chris: can we get a presence in multi-sports summer schools. Mike and Sol will consider this.

Emily stated that the account balance as of today is £15,183.

Accounts questions: Need to set rules about junior payments, mileage and not offsetting against next years fees. This can become very messy and hard to work out account yearly.

Need to set out rules about payments and people playing without paying.

George: Can we speak to Campbell about funding for new players and less affluent players. Yes Need to speak to George about how to encourage more kids from less affluent areas and get them into clubs and supporting them. – We will take this to the directors meeting.

County training for seniors – Andy will look at it but has sited problems to do with players also coaching a lot throughout the week and no being able to commit all the time. Selection committee will be asked to arrange this as the current committee is stretched.

Dave – Can this be very regular? Not weekly but maybe once a month. Monthly agreed.

Chris added this will help with selection.

Less exclusive – open to as many players around county standard as possible. This will be something that will need to be looked at for the start of the year.

Need to think carefully about this tieing into selection with players individual circumstances.

Dave mentioned umpiring. If anybody wants to learn to umpire the ad will be on the website very soon. Sam advertising referees as we are desperate. Again course details to be put on website by Ian George – CPD at Balcarras please speak to George. Ian to put this on website.

Mike- development plans are in the room and we welcome feedback. Also there is feedback from the secondary schools to read. Ian to put on the website.
